Safety Drills

All PPS schools practice <u>fire drills every month</u>, <u>as well as additional safety drills</u>, <u>throughout the</u> <u>year</u>. School staff are required to instruct students on emergency procedures for fires, earthquakes and safety drills. At Bridlemile we do so with preparation and communication beforehand. Our staff have conversations with students about why and how we practice safety drills and make space to hear and talk through questions and concerns. We also announce the type of drill over the intercom before we start the drill, and we make sure to let students know it is a practice drill. We also announce on the intercom when the practice drill is complete, and we compliment everyone on a good job practicing!

PPS just introduced Sammy the Sasquatch from *Sammy and Friends*, a new way to introduce "locks, lights, out of sight", one of our safety drills, to our youngest elementary students. Lockdown drills and instruction include appropriate action when there is a threat to safety inside the school. Click here to see a <u>brief video</u> and <u>here for more information</u>.

Our counselors will be reading *Sammy and Friends* to our K-2 classes during the first week of March, and then we will practice a follow-up safety drill together during the second week of March before **our school lockdown drill on Wednesday, March 20th at 8:30am.**
