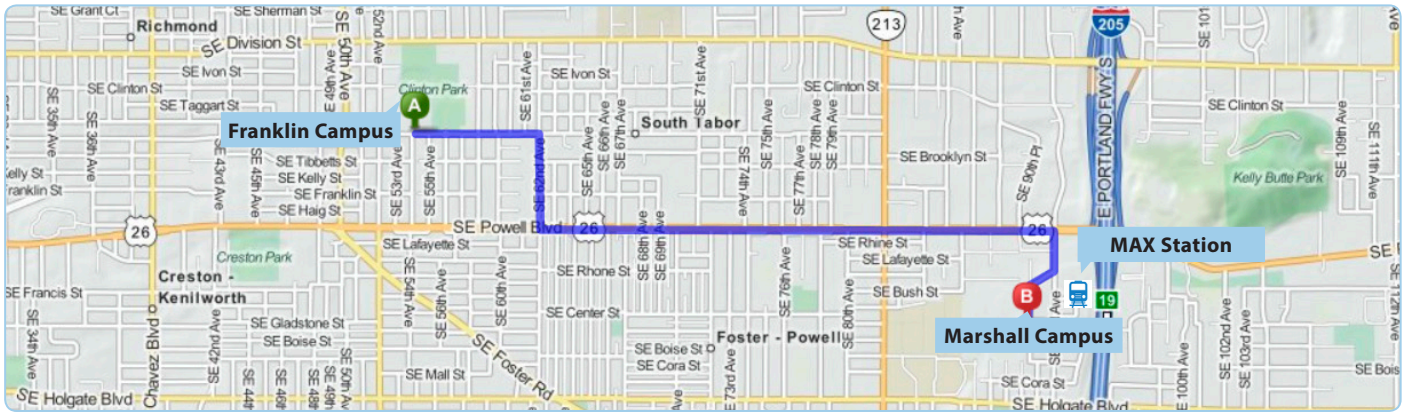




Franklin High School’s temporary move to the Marshall Campus during modernization of the Franklin campus

Franklin High School students and staff will attend school on the Marshall Campus for the school years 2015-16 and 2016-17 while the century-old Franklin High School campus is fully modernized. For the students, teachers and staff the buildings will be different but it will continue to be Franklin High School. This advisory is intended to help families understand what to expect.

How will students get to the Marshall Campus?

Franklin students will be able to use both private and free public transportation to reach the Marshall campus at 3905 SE 91st Ave. Portland Public Schools does not provide regular yellow school bus service to high schools in the District. However all Franklin students are eligible for a free Portland Public Schools High School Student Transit Pass. The Student Transit Pass program is a partnership among TriMet, the school district and the City of Portland.

What if my special education student currently gets special yellow bus service?

Yellow bus service for special education students will not change simply due to a change in school location. If your student is eligible now, they will still be eligible unless the IEP team makes a service change.

What can my student expect at the Marshall Campus?

The Marshall campus offers large classrooms, a spacious inner courtyard, a full cafeteria, auditorium, gymnasium, library and ample parking. In addition Marshall has a brand new turf field and track.

What is being done to prepare Marshall High School for Franklin Students?

Marshall is also being updated to accommodate the educational and safety needs of Franklin High School staff and student population. The work being done to accommodate the needs of the staff and students includes; fire alarm and IT system updates, roof repairs, classroom modifications as needed, and accessibility improvements.

Why was the Marshall Campus selected as the temporary home for Franklin and Grant?

During the planning for the voter approved bond measure, Marshall High School was selected as the best site to act as the temporary home for schools under construction (Franklin and Grant). As a recently closed high school facility, Marshall has all the space and infrastructure needed to provide a successful, temporary home for the Franklin and Grant communities.
