PPS requires 24 credits to graduate A full schedule of eight classes provides you with the opportunity to take maximum advantage of the educational opportunities available to you. Carefully review the list of courses available, consult with your parent/guardian and counselor as needed, and select eight (8) courses along with alternate course choices that meet your educational goals."

- 3. Place an X beside your 8 class choices, including PE & CCE, which are required for all freshmen.
- Select two alternate electives and place an A1 and A2 by your alternate elective choices.
- Discuss your choices with your parent/guardian. Both parent/guardian and student need to sign form on back.
