Head Start

Grout has two Head Start classrooms this year serving three and four year olds. If you have a three or four year old child, please contact Patti Schatz, Head Start Family Service Worker, at 503.916.6711 for more information.

School Success: Two things families can do to ensure school success: make sure your child gets enough sleep and learn that reading is important at home. Please make sure your child gets plenty of rest. 5-7 year olds need 10-12 hours of sleep a night. Older students, 8-11, still need 8-10 hours of sleep as well. Reading to, or with your child every night demonstrates the value you have for reading and helps a child learn to read and build their vocabularies that support them in school every day.

End of the Day Check Out of Classrooms: To ensure every child's safety during and after school, classroom educators were asked to check with families to gather information on how your child, grades K-5, go home. Classroom educators make an end of the day contact with each child by shaking their hand, doing and elbow bump or another method to acknowledge the student is leaving. It may take us a couple of extra minutes this fall, but we will be able to tell you the plan for going home if you ever have to call looking for your child.

Did you know that applying for free meals helps our school get funding?

We are encouraging all Grout families to submit a confidential application for free or reduced-price meals for the 2016-2017 school year, if your family meets the eligibility guidelines based on household size and income. Our school will receive additional Federal funding if enough eligible families apply. The additional funding helps pay for staff to keep class sizes small and support academic achievement for all students. The 2016-17 confidential family application may be completed online at www.pps.k12.or.us/departments/nutrition. You will receive a notification letter if your application is approved or denied.
