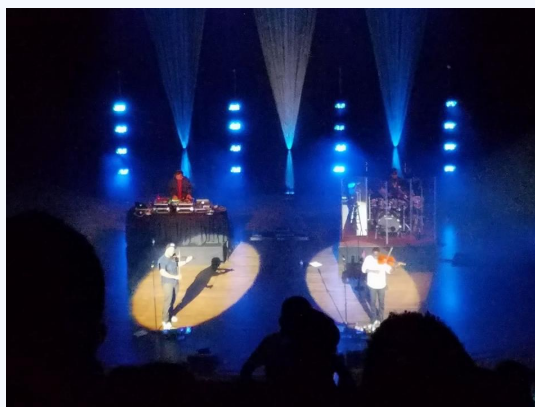


Peninsula School's Weekly Update

Local Health Advisory

As some of you may have heard, the Multnomah County Health Department has issued an advisory of 2 confirmed cases of Hepatitis A in restaurant workers at two Cup and Saucer Cafes in Portland. One of these is in North Portland. The Health Department is advising persons who visited the Cup and Saucer Cafe on N. Denver between March 22 and March 29, or the SE Hawthorne Cup and Saucer Cafe on March 22 or March 25, to contact their healthcare provider as soon as possible.

In addition, please be observant of any symptoms of hepatitis in your students, and send to the health room as well as notifying me directly:

- fever
- tiredness
- belly pain
- vomiting
- diarrhea
- jaundice (a yellowing of the skin or eyes)

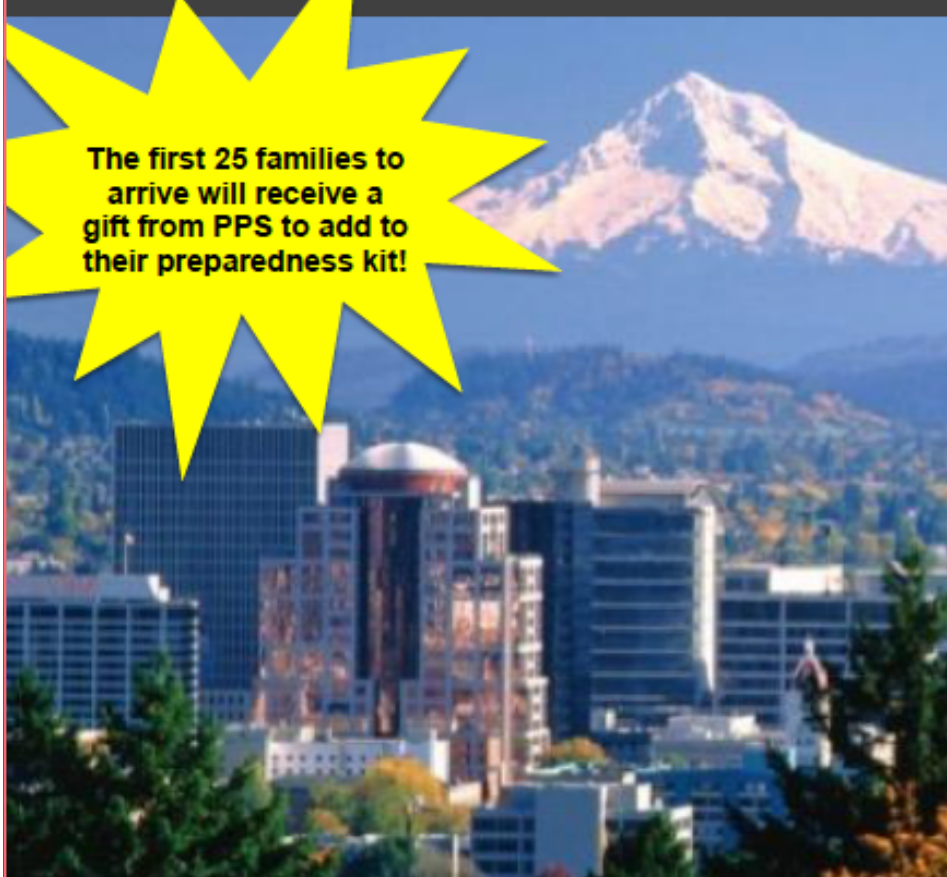
