"Forecasting provides you with the opportunity to identify the core courses required for you to graduate as well as elective courses available to you that can both enhance and support your school experience. PPS requires 24 credits to graduate. A full schedule of eight classes provides you with the opportunity to take maximum advantage of the educational opportunities available to you. Carefully review the list of courses available, consult with your parent/guardian and counselor as needed, and select eight (8) courses along with alternate course choices that meet your educational goals."

Directions:

1. Read through your course guide located online at the Lincoln High School website.
2. Select appropriate English, Math, Social Science, Science, World Language and two electives.
3. Place an **X beside your 8 class choices**, including PE & CCE, which are required for all freshmen.
4. Select two alternate electives and place an **A1 and A2 by your alternate elective choices**.
5. Discuss your choices with your parent/guardian. Both parent/guardian and student need to sign form on back.
6. Return this completed sheet to the **parent volunteer in the counseling office**.
7. If you do not turn in a sheet in or your schedule will be created without taking your interests into account.
