- May be required in proposal
- Improve project
- Test theory
- Tells the story
- Improve accountability
- Inform field
- Support fundraising



#### When is an Evaluation Plan Necessary?




- Results needed

- Required by funder...


## When is an evaluation plan necessary?

**Important note about the project evaluation**: A strong evaluation plan should be included in the application narrative and should be used, as appropriate, to shape the development of the project from the beginning of the grant period. The plan should include benchmarks to monitor progress toward specific project objectives and also outcome measures to assess the impact on teaching and learning or other important outcomes for project participants. More specifically, the plan should identify the individual and/or organization that have agreed to serve as evaluator for the project and describe the qualifications of that evaluator.






## Logic Model

## What are performance measures?

Program	Performance Measure
21st Century Community Learning Centers	1. Percentage of regular program participants whose achievement test scores improved from below grade level to at or above grade level.
Pell Grants/Student Aid Administration	<ol> <li>The gap between completion rates for Pell Grant recipients and the general student population will decrease each year</li> <li>At least 75 percent of Pell Grant funds will go to students below 150 percent of the poverty level</li> <li>Reduce Pell Grant overawards</li> </ol>
Elementary and Secondary School Counseling Program	<ol> <li>The percentage of grantees closing the gap between their student/mental health professional ratios and the student/mental health professional ratios recommended by the statute.</li> <li>The average number of referrals per grant site for disciplinary reasons in schools participating in the program.</li> </ol>
Ryan White	1. Reduce rate of deaths due to HIV infection
