

"A preliminary sustainability plan must be developed as part of the application to show how the community learning center will continue once the funding has been reduced to 90% in year, 80% in year 5, and ultimately, after 21st CCL funding ends. This sustainability plan must indicate how the program will sustainability plan must indicate how the program will will contribute to developing a vision and plan for financial capacity to support, and eventually sustain, the program after the five-year grant funding ends. The plan must include a specific description of the investments that each partner will make in the program aft the associated timeframes for securing each contribution. Please note that sub-grantees are not allowed to reduce services in years 4 and 5 to accommodate the reduction in funding."

Extent to which the applicant describes plans for sustainability that are likely to result in the project being sustained after federal funding ends. Includes a description of how sustainability will be integrated into the earliest stages of program planning.

Your proposal for funding will be evaluated based on the guidelines of the foundation in question and on the following criteria:

- Demonstration of effective organizational, programmatic and financial objective setting and management
- Evidence of diversity in support sources, with an accounting of funds received from public and private sources
- Evidence that the service is a response to a valid need, is superior to other competing services and/or encourages collaboration with other organizations for maximum leverage
- Documentation of previous program success or substantial reasons to expect such success in the future

12 Sustainability Factors (excerpt)

STAFF

"Staff have the skills, confidence, and interest in continuing new ways of working and improved outcomes."

Example:

Staff utilize a new curriculum that is more effective at achieving outcomes x, y, and z.

Staff use a train-the-trainer model to address high turnover rates at organization. This model ensures program fidelity over time.

SHARED MODELS

"Continued use of a shared model among those involved in the new ways of working."

Example:

Big Brothers Big Sisters of America uses a standard model of mentoring.



12 Sustainability Factors (excerpt)

PARTNERS

"Involvement of partners who actively support new ways of working and improved outcomes."

-Example

Two community health facilities sharing expensive diagnostic equipment and services.

An MOU that details the commitment of project partners to continue a specific process.

SPREAD

"Expansion of new ways of working and improved outcomes to additional locations".

Example:

Expanding a specific technique to match mentors and youth from one city to multiple cities with similar challenges and demographics.

Try Developing a Case for Partnerships

A Case for Partnership is not an official document. It is a one-page, bulleted list of talking points to use when communicating with a potential partner. It is also a straight-forward, logical appeal to the benefits of collaborating.

 Better to serve clients through working together (explain why your services are a good supplement to theirs).

Expanded outreach through referrals to them from your organization. \\

Expanded visibility to donors due to association with your organization, and their ability to offer more comprehensive services.

Multi-tenant facilities Group purchasing Accounting services Marketing services Consulting services Human Resources services


