Program Participation Fees: JackSUN does not refuse service to anyone based on the inability to pay. All fees paid are considered a Nonprofit donation to Impact NW to help cover staff, snack and educational material costs of running programming. Homework Club is always FREE and open to any student at any time who has turned in a current registration packet. Elective Enrichment classes have modest participation fees attached to them. Families that are able to pay are encouraged to do so. Regardless, for everyone attending Homework Club and for those unable to afford Elective Enrichment fees, everyone is asked to pay the \$10 per term snack fee covering student nutrition provided after school. We welcome any additional amount included as a donation to JackSUN that families are generous enough to offer. Refunds are not issued once deposited.
