#### 1. Our Graduation Rate

#### Our goal for 2016 is 92%

#### 4-year "Completer Rate" of 94% (BEST in PPS!)

 Reduce the rate of exclusionary discipline by 50% and close the gap by 50%

PPS keeps the data for every school and updates us quarterly on our progress. They provide training for administrators, Dean's on "restorative practices" to replace traditional practices that exclude (suspend/expel) students.

### 3. Improve Student Attendance "90/90 Initiative"

Taking steps to better track and intervene when students miss classes; *added staffing*; clear attendance policy; "train" parents to excuse absences.

 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Milestone – 100% of our 9<sup>th</sup> graders will start 10<sup>th</sup> grade with at least 6 credits and all their core classes passed.

Tied to the superintendent's priorities; data supported; long time priority for WHS/PPS – "Communities"; resources directed to this goal; 90-95+% every year.

5. Improve AP Outcomes -

Increase % of students passing one or more AP *Exam* (3/4/5) – 50% by 2017(?)
Increase the % of students taking an AP *class*

Increase the % of "traditionally underserved" students taking an AP class

Wilson's flagship program; 28% of the class of 2014 passed one/more AP test;
