Dear Glencoe Families,

What a wonderful week we have had. The sunshine and warm weather were a perfect addition to this week. Another great addition to this week - I learned that we have a PBS Kids TV Star in our midst. Sia Saturn one of our fabulous First Grade students, plays a role in an episode of Mega Wow by helping watchers learn some incredible balloon magic tricks through the power of science! Also, if you have some time this weekend, come by Glencoe and check out the newly installed gulls along the 49th street fence line. They will be up and ready for viewing on Saturday morning.

I don't know about you but I am still getting used to our new schedule. Having two learning models happening at the same time and having two cohorts (AM and PM) with two sets of start and end times is something for me to get used to. Even though the changes take some getting used to, I am seeing the benefits for many of our students as they learn how to navigate the two hours and 15 minutes of consecutive class time. This spring we are definitely working on stamina for learning in both our CDL and Hybrid classrooms. For some of our Hybrid students we have had to remind them that they still have asynchronous lessons and assignments to complete when they are not physically in the building. For some of our CDL students the schedule change of having their live instruction occur only in the AM or PM (as opposed to being spread out) is an adjustment. No matter what the circumstances, we will continue to work through the challenges to have a successful learning experience this spring. We can do this!

This spring term will most likely fly by, as the spring term usually does. We have a few activities happening this month that I want to tell you about. We have a virtual PTA meeting this coming Monday, April 19th at 6:00 pm. The following week we have our first of two Virtual Kindergarten informational sessions for our incoming Kindergarten Families. If you have a child who will be 5 years old on or before September 1st, 2021 I invite you to join us on Wednesday, April 28th at 6:00 pm. A meeting link can be found on our school website. We are also hosting another virtual Author's Visit. Dr. Arlyne Simon, the author of Abby Invents Picture Book Series will be joining us on Friday, April 30th at 6:00 pm and all Glencoe students and families are invited.

In last week's Newsletter I mentioned the two open teaching positions we have for next school year and I am happy to report we found two wonderful candidates to fill those positions. Jen Loveland, a teacher

from Richmond Elementary will be joining our 4th grade team putting us back at three sections of 4th grade. Jen has been a reading teacher at Marysville Elementary and a 4th and 5th grade teacher at Richmond Elementary for the past 9 years. We also have Stephanie Davis, a teacher of a K-2 Social Emotional Focus Classroom joining us from Marysville Elementary where she has been for the past 5 years.
