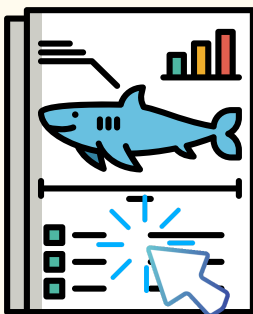

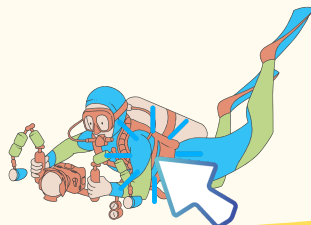

Dear Marysville Families,

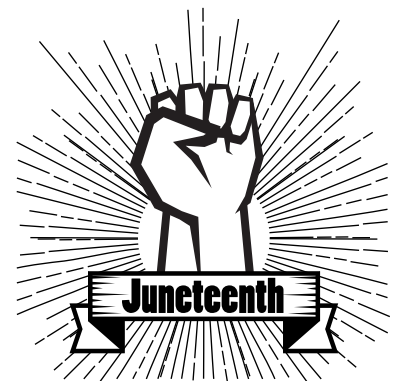
Starting Thursday, May 30th, the Marysville Library will be hosting a Free Book Fair with books donated from the SMART Reading Program. Each student will be able to choose up to 5 books to take home forever! The students will be able to book shop during their class' library time during the school day.

It's the end of the school year and there are still so many books checked out of the library! Please look to see if you have any Marysville library books at home, even if you think you don't! The books will have a barcode on the front that says Marysville and will have a Marysville stamp inside.

The Multnomah County Library's Summer Reading Program is all set to begin on June 16th. Gameboards will be provided at school, or you can pick one up at any of the MCL libraries. You can also play online with the [Beanstack](#) or on the Beanstack app.

Summer is a great time to start reading the [QBOB books](#)! Look for them at the Multnomah County Libraries. Students can read physical books, ebooks, or listen to audiobooks. They can also have someone read to them or watch videos of someone reading the books as well. It all counts!

The Multnomah County Library also has a program called [Library Connect](#) that will let students use their student ID numbers to access their library services like checking out physical books, ebooks, audiobooks, magazines, and use their homework help, no library card needed. If you have a library card already, you will still be able to use that. If you're unsure of what your child's student ID number is, ask their teacher, look on StudentVUE, or email someone in the office. JUNE ATTENDANCE



Dear families,

Thank you for your support this year with our attendance. We were able to maintain a daily attendance rate of 90%. However, our overall goal this year was to have 90% of 315 students with good or acceptable attendance. As we end the school year, we have had 68% of 315 students with good or acceptable attendance. Good or acceptable attendance means missing no more than two days per month. This also means that we had 32% of students who were chronically or severely absent and did not attend classes frequently enough to participate fully.

As you make your summer plans, please be aware that the first day of the 25-26 school year is August 26th, 2025. It's essential that your child is present during the first days of school to ensure a great start to the year.

Thank you for helping your students with our Attendance projects, including monthly assemblies, meaningful work, daily/weekly check-ins, and the attendance word challenge. Check out our May Attendance Assembly picture below.

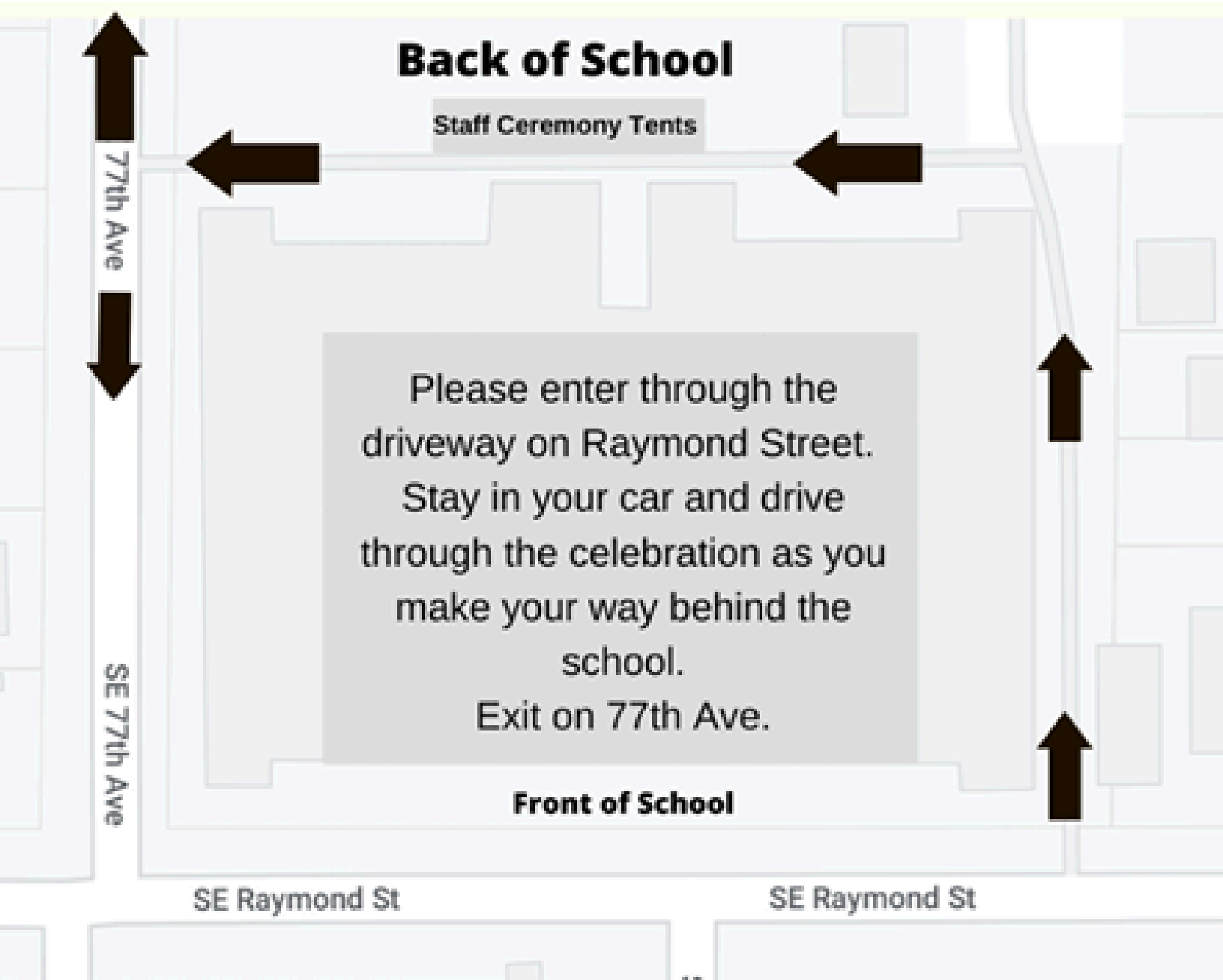
