Hello Marysville Families!

Vaccinations are a requirement for school registration. There are State requirements we follow to keep our students up to date on these vaccines. April 20, 2022 is the State Exclusion Day for students who are not up to date with their vaccinations. If your student(s) are not up to date, you will receive a letter with the immunizations needed. If you have already updated the vaccinations with your provider, then please provide a current copy to the office. If you have not, then please be sure to get this done as soon as possible. Students who are not up to date with their vaccinations or non medical exemptions by April 20th, will not be allowed to return per State guidelines until their vaccinations are complete and up to date. 
