PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Happy November and welcome to our second quarter of comprehensive learning. As we enter this next term we would appreciate your feedback. Please let us know what is working and what challenges continue. We have been hearing that sometimes students are having trouble completing asynchronous assignments independently. While we are committed to providing a comprehensive, and rigorous academic experience, your family well being is most important to us. We understand that distance learning brings with it many challenges day by day and that some assignments given as independent work, may not be really independent for your child. When that happens please contact your teacher to discuss alternatives, so that family members don't feel required to do every assignment alongside their student.

An important part of your student's daily schedule is the in-person google meet lessons with the teacher and class. Please make every effort to have your child join every class session available in the morning and afternoon. Especially in K-4, that is when new instruction takes place and where the teacher can directly assess your child's progress. Teachers will post assignments for students to do when they are not in the meet with their teacher. Your child should always attempt that assignment, if they can not do it independently (without your continuous, direct support), then please respond to the teacher either with a written note or recorded comment on the assignment that it was attempted, but the student was not able to complete it independently. In the moment an alternate activity could be one of the following:

- * 15–20 minutes of work on Dreambox, Lexia, Epic or STMath*
- * 15-20 minutes of independent Reading in a book of their choice*
- * 15-20 minutes of work on a paper packet*
- * 15-20 minutes of independent writing*

Thank you and please reach out to your classroom teacher to work together to find distance learning solutions. Remember that Marysville staff members are available to support students in completing any assignment or Seesaw activity everyday in a google meeting from 9:45 – 11:00am. Use the code marysvillehelp to join. Maintaining connections between families and classrooms is more important to us than ever. Fortunately, it's almost Conference Time! Teachers value this chance to sit down with you for an uninterrupted time to create meaningful connections around your child's educational experience. You know more about your student than anyone at school. Talking with the teacher about your student will help pave the way for your student to do well in class and will help you to understand what is happening at school. Please join us for virtual conferences on either Monday, November 23rd or Tuesday, November 24th. This year conferences will be held as Zoom video Conferences. Check in with your student's classroom teacher if you have not yet scheduled a conference or if you forgot your date and time. Your teacher will be sharing the Zoom meeting links with you and we will provide more information to you throughout the month. Please reach out if you have any questions.

CHILDCARE RESOURCES

Employment Related Day Care (ERDC) has raised the income limits to 250% of the poverty rate to allow many more families who usually wouldn't meet eligibility. For qualifying families, ERDC covers most or all child care costs. Qualifying families must be working and make less than 250% of the poverty rate.
