This program provides the following services and educational opportunities:

- Advice about academic, career, and vocational opportunities
- Exposure to career opportunities, college campuses, & academic programs
- Weekend and after-school workshops for academic courses, study skills, computer skills, career choices, and opportunities for education beyond high school
- Assistance with SAT/ACT preparation and registration
- Guidance with college admissions and financial aid & scholarship applications
- Referrals to educational services and financial literacy resources for participants and their parents

**Eligibility:**

- At least 11 years old and in the sixth grade
- Maintains at least a 2.50 GPA
- Qualifies within the income eligibility requirements
- Parents or legal guardian did not graduate from a four-year college
- Is a citizen or permanent resident of the United States
