

Connecting students with their ancestral past through methods that are based in tribal traditions, the Title VI Indian Education Program helps students instill a sense of pride and confidence so they can achieve the challenging academic standards we know they are capable of.

#### **Title VI Indian Education**

Title VI is a federally funded grant that supports schools in providing a unique and culturally related educational experience while ensuring Indian students gain knowledge and understanding of Native communities, languages, Tribal histories, traditions, and cultures, and that school leaders and staff are able to provide them with culturally appropriate and effective instruction.

### Who is eligible?

To register in the Title VI Indian Education program, students must meet federal eligibility requirements: the student, a parent, or a grandparent must be enrolled in a state, federally recognized, or select terminated tribe, band, or nation.

### How to register

The student's parent or guardian must complete a 506 form for each student, including the tribal enrollment information of the student, parent, or a grandparent. Submit the completed form to the Title VI Indian Education office. Please reach out to our office for assistance in the registration process.

### What services does Title VI provide?

- Provide culturally specific activities to students to increase cultural awareness and knowledge
- Track attendance, behavior, and achievements, providing support when appropriate.
- Connect students and families to resources needed to help students succeed.
- Work with students in groups at their schools, including affinity group support.
- Attend IEP, behavioral, and other meetings, when it is appropriate.
- Support teachers, principals, and other school staff in providing appropriate instruction and support.
