The District and Trip Leadership will not make any judgments regarding the safety of non-District public transportation (common carriers) used, traffic hazard situations, unlawful behavior of strangers and other dangers to be found in the surroundings and cannot be expected to control student behavior that is contrary to the directions given to the party or individuals in the party.
