#### Oregon Seniors: Oregon Promise application due June 1st.



- Must be a resident of Clackamas, Multnomah or

- Open to students planning to major or majoring in **science**,

#### computer science, engineering, or mathematics.

- Enrolled or planning to enroll full-time.
- Attending or planning to attend any public or private nonprofit college or university in the United States.
