First Robotics: Mondays (\$50)

FIRST robotics introduces science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) to children through fun, exciting hands-on learning. Led by Angie Smith, students will gain real-world problem-solving experiences through a guided, global robotics program, helping today's students and teachers build a better future together.

<u>First Tech Challenge: Wednesdays (\$0)</u> is a program where individuals interested in robotics and STEM work together, learning to engineer and code robots to compete in competition. It also involves several other essential skills such as teamwork, outreach, and problem solving. In this course, FTC members from the Ida B Wells robotics teams will teach you how to build and program basic robots using core FTC components, giving students an introduction to the world of FTC.
