Library Connect allows students to use their student ID to access Multnomah County Library. Library Connect is free and there are no late fees. Students are signed up with their school registration.

#### Students can use Library Connect to:

- · Check out books, movies and music.
- Download e-books and audiobooks, and stream movies and music.
- · Get help from online tutors in English, Spanish, and
- Get information online from National Geographic, World Book Encyclopedia, The Oregonian newspaper and more.

Your child's Library Connect number is the school district code + student ID number.

The password for a new Library Connect account is your child's birthdate. Please consider changing the password.

If your child already has a Multnomah County Library card, the Library Connect number will be added to their account.

Notices about holds and due dates will be mailed. You can change how notices are sent at multcolib.org/manage-my-account

If you do not want your child to use Library Connect, please contact your school.


