74% receive Free or Reduced Lunch.

26% are English Language Learners.

What is AVID?

AVID is an academic elective class during the school day that teaches students how to succeed in rigorous curriculum and prepares them for college and career success.

- Data represents students enrolled in an AVID elective class in 2018-19 in grades 6-12. Senior data is based on AVID Elective Seniors who graduated from Benson, Cleveland, Franklin, Grant, Lincoln Madison, and Roosevelt.
- Data for Wilson will be available once a cohort of AVID seniors has graduated.
