Student Schedules

Student schedules will be available to families at the Connect to HTMS event on the 30th or live on the 31st through Student/ParentVUE. We have a new schedule change request policy:

Schedules may not reflect the choices students forecast for in the spring. Unfortunately, due to staffing changes, we are not able to offer many of the elective classes that were listed on the past forecasting sheet. If you are missing a class period, core class or have another issue please use the Schedule Change Request Form. This must be filled out, requested by the student. Changes might not be possible based on capacity and logistics. Until your schedule is officially approved and changed, STUDENTS MUST ATTEND CURRENT SCHEDULED CLASSES. Priority will be given to core classes, IEP needs, 504 needs and 8th graders.

School Supplies

Each student will receive the following school supplies at Connect to HTMS. Supplies will include: 3-ring binder, 2 pocket folders(2) or subject dividers(8); spiral notebooks(2); pencils(12); highlighter(2); coloring pencils; pencil sharpener; pencil pouch; cinching backpack (by request only). Graphing composition notebooks will be distributed by math teachers.

Scholars who are unable to attend will receive supplies and welcome back information on their first day of school

First Day for Students/JumpStart Day

We have a solid plan to ensure our students are starting the year with plenty of support to reduce anxiety. On the first day of school, students will arrive at staggered times:

School Hours

The building opens for students at 9:07am and students are tardy at 9:15am. Please do not arrive earlier than 9:00am. Students enter designated doors by grade level. Student dismissal is at 3:45pm each day and students are immediately expected to be on their way home or to after school activities. Please pick up your student promptly each day if they do not ride the bus.

Student verification forms and take home materials will be distributed by the 8th period teachers, prior to dismissal on the first day of school. The Student Verification is especially important. Please update the information as needed, sign and date the form and return it to the teacher.

Student Drop-off/Pick-up Zone

Please use Commercial St., located on the westside of Lillis Albina Park, off Russell St. for drop-off/pick-up. This throughway is not for parking. For the safety of our scholars and staff assisting with arrival and dismissal, we ask families to refrain from driving through Flint Ave. - from Paige St. to Tillamook St. - during student transportation times. This stretch of road is our designated bus zone from 9:00am - 9:15am and 3:40pm - 3:55pm. We maintain consistent contact with the city to ensure that our passageways are safe and clear for vehicles and scholars.

Breakfast/Lunch

Breakfast and lunch is free to all students every day. Lunch is grab and go. By mandate all students must eat outside. We are working on our systems to accommodate this mandate and will keep families informed.
