Title 1 – Family Involvement Policy

Jason Lee Elementary School's Family Involvement Plan recognizes that a child's education is the responsibility shared by the school and family. To support the goal of educating all students effectively, the school and family must work as knowledgeable partners. Although families are diverse in culture, language, and needs, they share the school's commitment to the educational success of their children. We will give information to families in as many ways and or formats as we can. This includes, but is not limited to: Remind messages via text message, email and phone calls, Principal's Chats, Jason Lee website, the Lee Family Bulletin, and/or calls home as appropriate.
3. We want our parents to feel confident when talking to teachers and school personnel.  
We:
  - Provide opportunities to talk with teachers in groups and independently,
  - We promote parent education through our community partners,
  - We help our families understand school goals, school and state assessments and curricula through our PTA, curriculum nights, parent-teacher conferences, and
  - We meet with parents and families of students in special programs (TAG, ESL, AVID, and others) so that their child's academic program and services are clear.
4. All parents have the opportunity to participate in parent-teacher conferences, with interpreters. If needed, to discuss assessment results and student progress towards the benchmarks and standards.
5. We have an annual meeting to let parents know about Title 1 (Back-to-School night and parent-teacher conferences). All staff will provide parents with timely information about the program with opportunities for regular meetings at varied or flexible times to formulate parental input.
6. The Title 1 program shall be planned and implemented in consultation with parents. Parents shall be involved in an ongoing way in the review and improvement of the program through the annual meeting, Lee Site Council (LSAC) and the Parent Teacher Association (PTA).
7. A jointly developed Parent-Teacher-Student compact will outline the roles of parents, students, and teachers in working together for improved student achievement.
8. The Jason Lee Parent Family Involvement Policy is made available and understandable to all parents.
