School report cards will be released in October, but here's a sneak peak of those results.


There's some new language around focus and priority schools, called "comprehensive or targeted support," but Jason Lee didn't have any areas of concern this year.






School Environment

Academic Progress


INDIVIDUAL STUDENT PROGRESS


Year-to-year progress in English language arts and mathematics.



- What is Title 1-A?
 - Title 1A is the United States Government's largest education assistance program for schools.
 - Funds are used to provide programs to help children in reading and math.
 - Extra help (in addition to what they learn during math and reading time in the classroom)
 - Funding provided under ESEA


DESIGN OF OUR PROGRAM

- Schoolwide Title 1 Program / What does it look like?
 - EAs for reading support in all grade levels
 - Reading Coach that supports all grade levels
 - Small group, differentiated instruction
 - Greater than 2:1 student to Chromebook / Tech ratio, in addition to online programs like MyON, Dreambox, and Lexia

ASSESSMENTS AND MONITORING

- OAKS / Smarter Balanced, DIBELS / EasyCBM, etc
- Notification of your child's assessment results:
 - OAKS: Annually, reports sent home or distributed at conferences
 - Progress monitoring (coming home in Friday folders)
