

PPS 2021-22 Guidance Lexia

Lexia is an umbrella term for Core5, PowerUp and English. Lexia is the company name and Core5 & PowerUp & English are the program names. "Lexia" can be used to refer to all programs.	
PowerUp	English
Definition	
Lexia PowerUp is designed to help struggling and nearly-proficient readers in grades 6–12 become proficient readers and confident learners.	Lexia English Language Development is an adaptive blended learning program that supports Emergent Bilingual students' English language acquisition through academic conversations. The program integrates speaking, listening, and grammar in the subjects of math, science, social studies, general knowledge, and biographies.
Audience & Access	
Students in a comprehensive MS and HS enrolled in a reading intervention course via Synergy. Directions for Accessing Access is automatically open for students in grades 6-8 but enrolled in a K-8.	For 21-22 all 1st-5th grade Emergent Bilingual Students who are currently receiving services (does NOT include monitor students or those who have refused services). Students are rostered through Synergy. Students are attached to the teachers that they are rostered to in Synergy for the section ESESL . Students log in to Lexia English through the icon on their My.PPS portal
Usage	
When used in MS or HS, Lexia PowerUp should be assigned to students for up to 75 - 100 min per week. Students should not do more than 20 min a day. Lexia PowerUp can be used as a Tier 2 tool (for extra scoops) and a Tier 3 tool (for interventions) PowerUp is not a Tier 1 tool in MS or HS.	Students in grades 1st-5th should have 3 online sessions/week for 15-25 minutes. It is also recommended that students receive 2 teacher led lessons/week from the Resource Hub. Students can do the online sessions in either a push in or pull out model. They can do the online sessions during the Language Arts block as a station, during academic support, or with the ELD teacher in a pull out model. The teacher led lessons can be provided by the ELD teacher or classroom teacher during academic support or in
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Students should not work past one grade level above their current grade level. For example; Kinders should not go past 1st grade. Lexia is not designed as an extension tool.

Lexia Core5 can be used as a Tier 1 tool (for applied practice), a Tier 2 tool (for extra scoops) and a Tier 3 tool (for interventions). For Lexia to be it's most effective, teachers should check student data on the MyLexia dashboard twice per

Lexia Power Up is not appropriate for K-5 students, it is not an extension for students who have completed all 21 levels of Lexia Core 5.

Lexia English is not appropriate for students beyond 6th grade.

For Lexia to be most effective, teachers should check myLexia at least weekly to review their class and student data, and utilize the data to make instructional decisions

Staff Access

Due to rostering via Synergy all access is read only, which allows for full access with the exception of creating classes and moving students.

- Students have one account and multiple teachers can be assigned to access student data
- Students access Lexia via My.PPS portal
- Students have one account and multiple teachers can be assigned to an access student data
- Students access Lexia Enlgish via My.PPS portal (this is a different app than Lexia Core 5)
- Students have one account and multiple teachers can be assigned to access student data
