- All AP Exams are in person this year. Online testing is not available this year.
- Exams are May 2-6 and 9-13, 2022. (Full Schedule) at the Portland Expo Center.
- Portfolio-based exams (Art, Computer Science Principles, Capstone) - see your teacher for deadlines

## A few last things:

- **Two exams on the same day?** Sign up for both exams now. We will send you an updated schedule in January.
- **AP Exam Only sign up.** Do you want to sign up for an exam but aren't taking the class? Instructions here.

# **IMPORTANT DATES & DEADLINES:**

- Nov 1 Nov 1 Oline to complete Steps 1 4 AP Classroom -
  - AP Classroom & Exam Registration
  - Full Payment or Financial Aid Request
  - Students who miss this deadline can register in February (with late fee)
  - Nov 10 Last day to request exam cancellation without a penalty

- \$40 per exam cancellation fee after Nov. 10th

- Feb 1 25 Spring Registration & Late Registration Window
- March 1 Last day to cancel & receive a partial refund (cost of exam minus \$40 penalty)

- There are no refunds for cancellations after March 1st or for exam no-shows.

# Why is AP Registration so early and so strict this year?

The College Board found that students who REGISTER and COMMIT to taking their AP Exams early in the school year are much more likely to score a 3 or higher on AP Exams than those who register in February or March.

#### **IMPORTANT POLICIES: Please read**

**LATE REGISTRATION:** Students who miss the November 1st deadline can register and pay in February. They will be charged a \$40 late registration fee per exam.

#### CANCELLATIONS/NO SHOWS (Updated 10-2021):

Students who meet one of the financial aid criteria:

- They will have until Friday, April 22 to cancel with no penalty / no additional fee.
- If they do not cancel their exam by April 22nd and do not sit for the exam, they will be charged the unused or no-show fee of \$40. If there is an emergency or other unforeseen circumstances, we will make decisions about fees on a case-by-case basis.

Students who do not meet any of the official financial aid criteria and are requesting assistance:

- They have until November 10th to cancel with a full refund.
- They will have until Friday, April 22 to cancel with no additional fees. The \$35.00 initial exam fee will not be refunded.
- If they do not cancel their exam by April 22nd and do not sit for the exam, they will be charged the unused or no-show fee of \$40. If there is an emergency or other unforeseen circumstances, we will make decisions about fees on a case-by-case basis.
