PROGRAM OVERVIEW

LA/SS BLOCK

All 6th grade students are with the same teacher (their "block teacher") for two periods including Language Arts and Social Studies.

MATH

All students are enrolled in 6th grade Common Core math. The curriculum focuses on fractions, pre-algebra, statistics, ratios and proportional relationships, number systems, and geometry.

SCIENCE

Science will cover life, physical, and earth sciences throughout the school year. This is a hands-on class with inquiry projects, labs, and experiments.
