Faubion SUN CS Program is ran by Portland Parks and Recreation and provides an after-school program that promotes student success by extending the school day through enrichment, academic, and culturally specific classes. **SUN** (Schools Uniting Neighborhoods) also provides adult classes &workshops as well as family events. Community Schools serve as "mini" community centers by keeping a public building open & active after school hours and brining youth & family opportunities directly to the neighborhood and school community.

SUN CHILDCARE?

PICKUP POLICY

Pickup ends at 5:30pm. After 5 minutes there is a late fee of \$1 a minute per child. Due upon picking up your child

ATTENDANCE POLICY

Since space is limited, more than 2 unexcused absences will result in a student being dropped from the class to make room for someone on the waiting list.

HOW DOES REGISTRATION WORK?

First Come, First Serve.

Priority is given to students with academic risk factors (SAVE A SUN SPOT) which are determined by Faubion Teachers. This means that placement is ultimately left up to the discretion of SUN and Faubion School staff.
