- All underclass students take 8 classes per semester

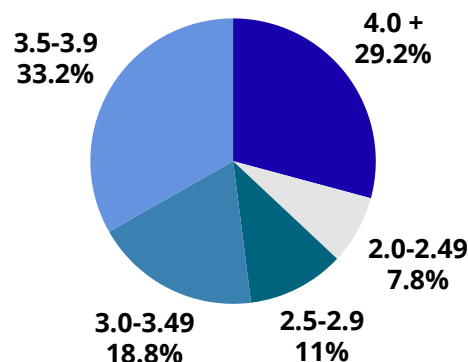
