Encourage students to bundle up and join Safe Routes to School as we walk and roll to school on National Winter Walk & Roll to School Day, February 7th, 2024.

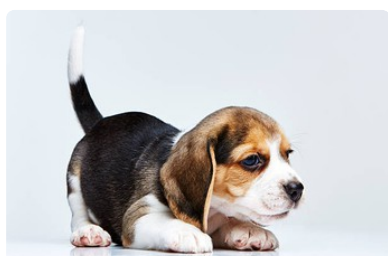
