### **Bridlemile News**

Students have been hard at work taking a mid-year math assessment. This diagnostic assessment is part of our iReady math curriculum; it is online and gives us a snapshot about student progress towards our priority standards. This assessment also updates a student's MyPath for their individual student lesson work.

Students have growth targets based on their fall testing, and this is a good opportunity to review student progress. As we did in the fall, we will send printed copies of iReady Math Diagnostic Reports

and Grades 2-5 MAP Reading and Math assessments along with report cards.

#### Ask Your Beagle!

Students are finishing up a Life Sciences Unit across all grade levels. What questions might you have for your children based on what they're learning at their grade level?

- Kindergarten looks at how living things survive in the places they live.
- Grade 1 looks at structure and function of animal body parts, with some biomimicry engineering towards the end of the unit.
- Grade 2 examines the connections between plants and animals, as well as how sun and water affect a plant's growth.
- Grade 3 examines how organisms depend on their environment and each other to survive, with a focus on honeybees.
- Grade 4 focuses on internal and external structures of animal body parts and involves owl pellet dissections.
- Grade 5 examines how energy flows and matter cycles between the environment and organisms.
