MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Hello Bridlemile Community,

I hope all is well with you and your families. I wanted to provide an update regarding the upcoming hybrid in-person learning and CDL.

I know everyone is anxiously awaiting pertinent information on the changes that will take place during 4th quarter. There are still a lot of moving parts and I'll start this letter by saying there is still a lot that is being decided.

What I can share today is this:

- PPS is still finalizing staffing which prevents us from sharing cohorts at this time. I am expecting that I will be able to share this information by early next week.
- We asked previously for parents to clarify whether their child would participate in hybrid or CDL, and for parents to send that clarification directly to the office. Thank you for doing so! We heard from many families and are doing our best to support you as we can. Please understand as of today, we are not able to take any further requests or changes due to staffing and capacity. However, if you have an extenuating circumstance or serious issue with your child's learning plan, please email bridlemile-office@pps.net. We'll do our best to work with your family, but cannot guarantee a specific outcome.
- We also understand that asking you not to make changes to your preferences after a
 certain time period, without having all of the information around cohorts and staffing for
 hybrid and CDL, was a tough ask. We hope that you understand that it is extremely
 difficult to schedule around all the multiple considerations that are involved. This is why
 we want families to focus on choosing a hybrid model or a CDL model.
- As previously communicated, please keep in mind that there is a possibility that some families will not be able to keep their current teacher due to staff availability and classroom capacity restrictions.
- We are however, trying our best to ensure that our students will at least have a
 Bridlemile teacher for hybrid and CDL, but even this is not guaranteed. I truly appreciate
 your flexibility and understanding that we will not be able to accommodate all
 preferences.
- Transportation is extremely busy putting together schedules for the entire district and we are looking for those schedules to be released as soon as possible.
- PPS has sent multiple communications out to all families including asynchronous schedules for the week of March 29th. If you have not received the communications, please go to the <u>PPS Reopen</u> webpage for all district updates.
- March 29th, 30th and 31st, teachers will be training and planning for the return to in-person instruction and CDL. All students will be provided asynchronous work for these days.
- Our K-1 classes will have a soft start of April 1st **or** April 2nd:.

- All K-1 AM cohorts will be in the building on Thursday, April 1st
- All K-1 PM cohorts will be in the building on Friday, April 2nd.
- Our 2nd-5th grade AM and PM cohorts will start on April 5th, marking the first day all students will attend hybrid learning together, including K-1. Your teachers will be sending more communication regarding these instructional days.
- More information will be coming soon regarding schedules, student drop-off/pick-up and building entry, how to screen your child before coming to school, safety protocols, and much more.

Please bear with us as we continue to work hard to ensure that we finish out this school year strong. Your continued patience, support and flexibility is greatly needed and appreciated. We look forward to the opportunity to welcome students back to in-person instruction and it will take the entire Bridlemile community to make the rest of this school year a success.

Before I close this letter, I would like to share my deep sadness regarding the horrific shootings that took place in Georgia recently. My heart goes out to all of the victims's families, friends and the Asian and Pacific Islander Community.

At Bridlemile, we are honored to have such a rich and diverse community and in times like these, it is important for us to stand in support and compassion for one another. So we stand in support of our Asian and Pacific Islander Community at this time and we stand against all racism. We send our love and support to all those who are affected by this terrible tragedy.
