We use this feedback to make informed decisions about Bridlemile school climate and culture. Grades 3-5 students at Bridlemile will be taking the survey in school in the next two weeks. (District-wide, all students in grades 3-12 will take the PPS survey.) PPS families, staff and administrators also take part in the anonymous survey.

At Bridlemile, we use the School Success Survey results to inform our school improvement plan goals.

2024-25 School Day Schedule and Early Release Days

Beginning 2024-25 school year, PPS has added 15 instructional minutes for elementary school students.

- At K-5 schools, students will now start at 8:00 AM and end at 2:30 PM
- On Early Release Days (8 days in the 2024-25 calendar year), the student school day will end at 11:45am.

Early Release for Staff Professional Meeting and Learning will occur on the following dates in 2024-25: 9/25, 10/23, 11/20, 12/18, 2/26, 3/19, 4/23, 5/21

Class Placement

We are reaching the time of year when we begin putting together our classes for the 2024-25 school year. Assigning students to classes is an important task that Bridlemile staff takes very seriously.

Our goal is to develop a diverse classroom learning environment that reflects a balance of abilities, talents and cultures. We have a dedicated staff, trained and prepared to meet the needs of all students. All classes are expected to deliver the same rigorous, standards-aligned curriculum in each grade level.

Therefore, in whichever class your child is placed, you can expect them to be challenged at their appropriate grade level instruction. Please do not approach your child's current teacher to make classroom placement requests.

We value and appreciate parent input and <u>have an optional Google survey linked for you to</u> <u>complete regarding your child.</u> This is an **optional** questionnaire; please only fill out this form if there are considerations above and beyond what your classroom teacher needs to be aware of when developing a classroom roster.

Current classroom teachers, specialists and administration will work collaboratively to develop class rosters. This process is intended to be respectful of everyone. **Please do not comment on or make requests for specific teachers.**

Also, if you are planning to move out of the Bridlemile area, please inform Bridlemile office and your classroom teachers as soon as you know. This information helps us through the summer as it impacts our class lists. Please drop us a line at Bridlemile office!

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
