### School Supplies for 2024-25

Starting next school year, Bridlemile will purchase school supplies in bulk for all our K-5 students. This ensures that students have all the needed materials that the homeroom teacher has requested and that each student has the same items. This will also reduce the cost of supplies for families. What this means is that you don't need to trek to the store or do any on line ordering for school supplies! Avoid the crowds, avoid the hassle! On the first day of school all your student's school supplies will be in the classroom!!



Please consider making a \$35 **donation** per student in your family in order to offset the cost of these supplies. We have had to use a considerable amount of our budget to ensure materials are here prior to the first day of school.

If this donation request would cause a hardship for your family, please note that **payment is not required** in order for your student(s) to receive supplies. All Bridlemile students will receive school supplies.

You are welcome to donate the amount that your family is comfortable with or even consider donating an additional amount on behalf of another student. All donations will be used to pay for,

but not limited to: substitutes, additional supplies, and curriculum materials. Bridlemile's Tax ID donation information is included on the SchoolPay receipt.

You may pay by cash, check (payable to Bridlemile School), or you may also pay electronically through PPS' <u>SchoolPay</u>, set up directly for school supplies.

If you wish to donate to support another Bridlemile family please make sure to write a note in <u>SchoolPay</u> that the extra funds are intended to cover another family. Thank you for your continued support of Bridlemile.






## Monthly featured book for No Place For Hate

The May monthly featured book for No Place For Hate is Rose Spoke Out: The Story of a Rose Schneiderman written by Emma Carlson Berne and illustrated by Giovanni Abeille. The book just arrived at the Bridlemile library and will be shared with grades K-5. The story features themes of hope, making a difference, community, and working together. Rose was a young immigrant who worked in a cap factory in New York City. She saw that women workers earned much less than men and that the factory was cold and dirty. Rose spoke up for better conditions and the International Ladies Garment Workers Union was born. We are excited to share this book with our students this month!
