Successful Schools Survey–Final 2 weeks of survey window

At Bridlemile, we use the School Success Survey results to inform our school improvement plan goals regarding school climate and culture. Last year, we received 75 family responses. This year, we have 53 responses so far. We encourage families to share feedback so we can best support your needs.

Four segments of the PPS community will take part in the anonymous survey:

1. Student surveys in grades 3 through 12 will cover teacher-student relationships, sense of belonging, school safety and climate, engagement, cultural awareness, and diversity and inclusion.
2. All PPS family surveys will cover school fit, school climate, barriers to engagement, and school safety.
3. All PPS staff will cover school climate, relationships, educating students, growth mindset, staff-family relationships, and school safety.
4. All PPS building leaders will cover school climate, staff-family relationships, district leadership relationships, overall district engagement, professional learning, feedback and coaching, and staff engagement.

Please select Bridlemile from the down-down menu. Families with more than one student in PPS can respond for their eldest student or take the survey more than once. There are 50 questions and the survey will take approximately 10-15 minutes. Bridlemile Site Council will review family responses and we will share the results from the Successful Schools Survey. Social Emotional Learning Curriculum–A Look Ahead for Next Year

Social Emotional Learning in the classroom is one opportunity where students and staff strengthen concepts of identity, agency and student sense of belonging.

Next year, Bridlemile staff will begin implementing a new social emotional learning curriculum. Wayfinder is also the curriculum used at both Robert Gray Middle School and West Sylvan Middle school, and this continuity of program will support consistent language and program focus. One feature of Wayfinder that we find especially helpful is a family resource portal with web based resources and activities for additional family engagement.
