We wanted to share with you some ways we are looking to streamline our classroom supplies process. We have taken some initial steps to reduce cost and waste:

- Grade level teams have been intentional about what supplies to ask for (e.g. we only ask for the brand if that's a must-have).
- We have looked at needs across grade levels and have also reduced the number of supplies based on what we already have.
- Please do not label supplies with student names. Most supplies will be used communally.
- We plan to have supplies drop off on the days before school starts to avoid the first day of school supplies jam.

In Fall 2023, we will survey families regarding the classroom supply process and what changes

pay for supplies via SchoolPay.
