Emergency Response Plans

Ask your child about our fire drill practice yesterday. Students did a great job practicing our evacuation procedure. All schools are required to instruct students on emergency procedures for fires, earthquakes and safety threats. We do so with preparation and communication beforehand. Our staff have conversations with students about why and how we practice safety drills and make space to hear and talk through questions and concerns.

We practice <u>fire drills every month and additional safety drills throughout the year</u>. Towards the end of September, we will practice a school Lockdown drill. Lockdown drills and instruction include appropriate action when there is a threat to safety inside the school building to include the method of "lock, lights, out of sight'.
