Dear Bridlemile Families,

Last spring, I was eager to share with you the news Bridlemile received from the PPS Office of Teaching and Learning Department regarding our **iReady curriculum embedded math scores**.

Bridlemile was noted as one of the schools where students demonstrated **high performance** relative to the national norm and **high typical growth**. We were encouraged by this news because we were intentional in our focus on math and the alignment of our instructional practices.

I'd like you to know that we have seen the **same growth in our math scores demonstrated on the Oregon State Assessments,** an annual assessment that students in grades 3-5 take at the end of the school year. I am proud of what our students and staff accomplished last year and continue to build on this year.

PPS will be mailing home Oregon State Assessment individual student reports home next week. I will have more school level reporting to share in the weeks to come and plan to provide more information about the why and how we use assessment data to inform our instructional practice.
