PARENTVUE STUDENT VERIFICATION DUE OCT 28TH

The deadline to complete your Parentvue Yearly Student Verification is October 28th. After the 28th, if you try to login to Parentvue you will get a message that prompts you to complete the YV before you can access your account.

***It is important to have your account active so that you are able to see your student's quarterly report cards.

OBOB (Oregon Battle of the Books)

OBOB (Oregon Battle of the Books) is returning to Bridlemile this winter. OBOB is a fun, voluntary statewide reading program that encourages 3rd-12th graders to read a variety of books in order to compete with other teams by answering comprehension questions.

Ms. Dahinden recently introduced OBOB to the 3rd-5th graders and handed out permission slips/team registration forms. **Team registration forms are due November 3rd.** Return forms to the library Tuesdays-Fridays.

Interested students should work together to create a team of 4 (or 5 with an alternate) and make a plan to read the 16 OBOB titles for this year. Kids can read to themselves, listen to an audiobook or have the book read to them. Books are available at the Bridlemile library and through your local library. Practice questions can be found online and will be emailed to registered teams as they are available. We plan to hold most battles during lunch recess, so please make sure teams are limited to students in the same grade.

Book battles will begin in January and the school champion will be determined by mid February. The school champion will go on to compete in the regional tournament. The state competition will be held in Salem on April 15, 2023.
