PPS COVID-19 Monitoring Dashboard

New Bus Route Check Tool



Because of the severe bus driver shortage, PPS has experienced day-to-day changes with routes on which there is not a driver available. Parents can monitor these changes via a new route check system linked to the main PPS website. Above is a snippet from the website of what to look for. Parents can go

to either the Bridlemile homepage <u>School Website</u> or district homepage <u>www.pps.net</u> and click on the banner or <u>pps.net/routecheck</u> to receive live updates of impacted routes.

MESSAGE FROM PRINCIPAL TOWNSEND

Hello Bridlemile families,

I hope all is well with each of you. Please take note of the following updates/requests

- We are still working with PBOT in order to assess our traffic concerns; especially during our dismissal. In the meantime, please continue to adhere to state laws and practice safe driving.

Student Profile Verification

If you have not completed the Yearly Verification in ParentVue for your student, an email was sent to you last week.

Guidance from the District:

- Online Yearly Verification via ParentVUE deadline is October 31, 2021
- · Beginning on November 1, 2021, if you have not submitted the online YV, you will receive the following message upon login to PVUE: 'The Yearly Verification process must be complete to continue.'

This is a hard stop to log in to PVUE. You will not be able to access your account. The only options if you want to log in to your account are to click **Begin Yearly Verification** or click **Logout.**

****If you wish to do the Verification via paper copy, please contact the office for a printout of your Student's Profile. Review and make changes on the paper copy, sign and date it and return

to the office before October 31st.

The verification process should not take more than a few minutes and it is very important that we have the most updated information in Synergy to ensure the safety of your student. Only one parent needs to complete the online verification.

Log on to your ParentVue account <u>ParentVue.pps.net</u> Review and update as needed. Be sure you select the <u>YEARLY VERIFICATION</u> tab from the menu.

School Pay

SchoolPay is an online web tool that allows families to pay for items such as registration fees, athletic fees, event tickets, uniforms, library fees and donations without having to make a special trip to the school or send a check with their students. It also provides the convenience of paying by Visa, MasterCard or Discover Card online or onsite.

Parents and guardians, you are able to use one log-in at SchoolPay to see all items available to you. You will also be able to see the payment history for each of your students.
