# **MESSAGE FROM PRINCIPAL TOWNSEND**

Hello Bridlemile Families,

I hope all is well with each of you. As you know, the winter months are upon us. The daily temperatures are colder and we are experiencing rain more often. With this change in weather there is a need to adjust how we facilitate our student lunch periods. Adjustments will be made not only due to weather conditions but because of contractual duty adjustments for staff as well.

Starting Monday, December 6, 2021, students will eat lunch inside of the building and recess

will continue to be held outside. With this change, we will continue to follow district Covid-19 Safety Guidelines.

During lunch:

- Students will be spaced at 6ft on the cafeteria floor as well as hallways when needed.
- We will continue to utilize volunteers to help facilitate lunch and recess.
- Students should dress appropriately for the weather as recess will continue to be held outside under the covered area.

Adjusting the schedule and putting it into action on December 6th will allow staff to adjust their schedules and prepare students for the change. It will also allow time for parents who choose to have their students vaccinated to go through the process. We will share the final updated schedule upon returning from Fall Break.

# **IMMUNIZATIONS**

Please continue to bring in updated immunization information. This information must be provided to the school for input into the district's immunization database so that your child's record will reflect that they are up to date. Letters were mailed to parents whose children have incomplete immunization information. Should you receive a letter, please provide requested information as soon as possible. The school nurse Trudy Davis is available to address any questions that you may have. If you need assistance in locating a health care provider or clinic site, please contact Trudy <u>tdavis@mesd.k12.or.us</u>.

# PEDIATRIC VACCINATIONS

As you may be aware, fully-vaccinated students and staff are able to stay at school if asymptomatic, even if they have been exposed to a COVID-19 positive individual. Now that a pediatric COVID-19 vaccination is available for children ages 5-11 years, you can locate pediatric vaccinations by:

- 1. Check with your child's pediatrician; or
- 2. Log into Multnomah County Health Department's vaccine locator website and:
  - 1. Enter your address or zip code under "Location."
  - 2. Click "Search"
  - 3. Click "Filter Your Results"
  - 4. Click "Pfizer age 5-11" under Vaccine Type.
  - 5. Click "Apply Filters" under Date Range.
  - 6. View the list of Pediatric Vaccine Clinics under Provider Information.
  - 7. Contact the Pediatric Vaccine Clinic provider for appointment information.

#### **COVID SCREENING TESTING UPDATE**

We have successfully launched our COVID Screening program at Bridlemile! Thank you to the participating families for your cooperation and patience. Below are some resources, reminders and updates.

Test Results: OHSU will provide results directly to families.

- All Positive and Inconclusive results will receive a phone call from OHSU
- OHSU is not permitted to share results with PPS, so we are dependent upon families to inform us of the results. Please be sure to report ALL Positive and Inconclusive results to the office.
- If your family has not received information from OHSU, please check your SPAM folders, ensure we have the correct email address listed as primary in Synergy ParentVUE. You can also reach out to OHSU directly at 833-376-1027 or <u>K12covidtesting@ohsuhealthmarketing.com</u> for further support.

**Important reminder:** if your student has had COVID in the last 3 months they should NOT submit a sample as they are likely to test positive with this screening test.

**To unenroll:** If you no longer wish to participate in the program, please send an email to the Bridlemile Office <u>bridlemile-office@pps.net</u> and we will unenroll you from the program.

- Meeting with the youth on a weekly-basis
- Tutoring Teaching good study habits
- Providing additional opportunities to build skills
- Able to gain access to resources and existing supportive caring relationships
- Build on youth's strengths
- If applicable, explore youth's cultural heritage through a variety of activities and service-learning opportunities.


