Reminders for Bridlemile Families

Please remember to drive slowly and safely around Bridlemile school at all times. Fall and winter seasons bring darker mornings and not all (especially small children) are easily visible. We have a lot of foot traffic near our school so please do your part to make sure everyone is safe by slowing down.

The earliest students can be dropped off at school is 7:45 AM for breakfast. Students eating breakfast should enter through the front door. Student's not eating breakfast should line up on the covered playground (kindergarten students arrive at the kindergarten gate)

Picture Retakes

Picture retake day is Wednesday morning, November 9th. Students getting retakes should return their original picture packets to the photographer on retakes day (If picture packets are forgotten or not available, the student will still get their picture taken).

There is no fee required to retake pictures, unless parents did not originally purchase a picture packet (example: if you missed the first picture day and didn't purchase a picture packet, you would pay for a picture packet at the time of retakes). NEWS FROM THE BRIDLEMILE GARDEN!

Hello Bridlemile Families,

I hope you all are enjoying the start of fall! My name is Max Krieger and it is such a joy to be your garden educator this year through Grow Portland. All K-5 students are receiving a monthly garden lesson with me. Our first lesson focused on getting re/acquainted with the learning garden through many experiential and multi-sensory activities such as scavenger hunts,

crafting nature bracelets, seed sorting, cultivating and watering raised beds, and tasting cucumbers, mouse melons, cherry tomatoes, and arugula flowers.

Our second lesson focused on abundance and reciprocity. Students celebrated the fall harvest by tasting locally grown apples donated by **Portland Nursery**. Students cared for the garden by harvesting, watering, mulching, and planting carrots, radishes, kale, baby choi, lettuce, and cilantro. **So far this fall, over 20 pounds of tomatoes, cucumbers, peppers, and beets have been harvested by students and given to the cafeteria for use in school lunches! We have also planted In the coming weeks we will plant overwintering garlic and cover crops.**

On September 25th, we had our first work party of the school year. We had a total of 19 volunteers and we got so much done, including spreading bark mulch on the paths and clearing the wild rose that has been taking over the bioswale and raised beds. Please stay tuned to get involved with more work parties throughout the year. Or, if you are interested in volunteering during garden lessons with your student's class please reach out to their teacher.

Join us! The non-profit I work for, <u>Grow Portland</u>, is growing! We are recruiting new board members, especially those interested in our treasurer position. No previous board experience required, we welcome folks with diverse lived experiences who are committed to the work of garden education. Please share this <u>interest form</u> with your community.
