### **Fundraiser for Beloved Staff Member**

Our dear friend, colleague and Bridlemile family member Joia Mencher-Spivey, who has provided loving support to students and families at Bridlemile for almost a decade, was diagnosed with a rare bone marrow cancer in February 2022. She underwent a bone marrow transplant at OHSU last summer, and was hospitalized for 58 days.

Since being released from the hospital, Joia has endured numerous complications from the transplant, resulting in an ongoing need for in-home care and mobility support. These unexpected side effects of treatment have created significant financial strain for Joia and her husband Leonard.

A fundraiser has been created to help Joia and Leonard hire the in-home care Joia will need for the next 6-8 months, thus allowing Leonard to return to work full-time.
