At each elementary school, the Multnomah Education Services District (MESD) School Health Services program offers an annual vision screening for students in Kindergarten, Grade 1, and Grade 3. A "vision screening" is an eye screening test to identify potential vision health concerns. Kindergartners and 1st grade students also receive a hearing screening on the same day. The School Nurse oversees these screenings. Screening results for vision and hearing are sent home to parents/guardians. Yay for K! We will be hosting our annual Kindergarten Connect Event for families with incoming Kindergarteners for the 2023-24 school year on February 8th in our cafeteria. We are very excited to once again have this event in person!

Missoula Children's Theatre Returns to Bridlemile

We are excited to offer all K-5 Bridlemile students an opportunity to participate in a Missoula Children's Theatre production here at Bridlemile! What is Missoula Children's Theatre? The Missoula Children's Theatre (MCT) is the nation's largest touring children's theatre. MCT has been touring extensively for nearly 50 years, from Montana to Japan and will visit nearly 1,100 communities this year.

MCT, in conjunction with the Bridlemile PTA, will provide a week long residency at Bridlemile beginning Monday, January 30th. Students will audition, rehearse and perform a production of Hansel and Gretel!

How does my child participate?

Parents must complete a permission slip linked here: <u>Missoula Info sheet and Permission Slip</u>. Hard copies are available in the office. Students participating will stay after school on Monday, January 30th, 2:30 to 4:20pm for auditions in the cafeteria. There is no cost to audition. Auditions are a fun and interactive group audition, and no advance preparation is necessary.

Cast announcements will be made after auditions at 4:20pm. Parents are invited to attend this part of the afternoon. All students must be picked up by 4:30pm (or go to aftercare). Parents of students who receive a role will have a quick informal meeting at 4:30pm (communications also sent via email) and some roles will be expected to remain for a rehearsal until 7:45pm. *MCT works very hard to create roles for as many children as possible. However you may want to prepare your child in advance, that even though they audition, it's possible that they may not receive a part.*

When will the performance of Hansel and Gretel take place?

Performances will be held in the cafeteria on Friday, February 3rd at 6:30pm **AND** a Saturday matinee on February 4th at 10:30am.

What are the rehearsal and performance expectations?

Students need to be prepared to begin rehearsals immediately following the auditions, should they be chosen for a role. Students in the play are expected to clear their schedules for the entire week of January 30th - February 4th. Participation in both performances and all rehearsals is mandatory. Rehearsals will be held between 2:30pm and 7:00pm, though younger students can expect shorter rehearsals, exact times TBD. There is no charge to audition, but there is a \$45 expense fee for those students who do get a role in the play. Full scholarships are available to anyone through the school counselor.
