# **MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL**

Dear Bridlemile Families,

As we transition into November, I would like to remind parents about our Fall Book Fair from November 19th through November 22nd. The Fall Book Fair is a wonderful fundraiser coordinated by our dedicated PTA and directly benefits and supports Bridlemile students. Additionally, I want to remind you about parent/teacher conferences on November 21st (evening), 25th and 26th. If you have not yet signed up for a parent/teacher conference, please do so by contacting your child's teacher. Parent/teacher conferences are a great opportunity for you to hear more about your child's progress in the classroom and to ask questions about supporting your child's academic success for the remainder of the school year.

Thank you again for a wonderful start to the year. I look forward to seeing you at our upcoming school events and parent/teacher conferences on November 21st, 25th and 26th.

#### PARKING LOT DROP OFF LANE

Suggested for **grades K-2**. <mark>Parents remain at wheel and have children quickly exit passenger side</mark> <mark>of vehicle.</mark>

- 1. The drive-through drop off area is for **quick drop-offs**. If your child needs more time or is unable to exit the car on their own please park on the street and walk them in.
- 2. **Drop off**: Enter the parking lot and proceed to the right. This will take you down the parking aisle that runs along the side of the building.
- 3. Please do not drive down the center lane of the parking lot.
- 4. We ask that you have your children exit the car as quickly as possible. Delay creates traffic back up that extends back onto 47<sup>th</sup> and down to Hamilton. \**To alleviate congestion, it is recommended that you exit the parking lot to the right and use the roundabout at 43<sup>rd</sup> Ave to turn around.*

#### STREET DROP OFF

Suggested for grades 3-5. Parents remain at wheel and have children quickly exit passenger side of vehicle. This drop off location must be south of the intersection (SW 47th Dr. and SW 44th Ave). Just east of the yellow painted section of curb.

- Please drop your child off east of the bus zone (towards the park) on the south side of 47th. <u>There is</u> <u>NO PARKING east the cones between 7:45am-8:15am. This is a DROP OFF ONLY ZONE</u>. Students can enter the playground from Hamilton Park or down the stairs from the bus zone.
- 2. If parents do need to drop off on the north side of 47<sup>th</sup>, please do so near the zebra striped crosswalk where our Safety Patrol is located at SW 48<sup>th</sup> Way. Students should use the safety patrol zebra striped crosswalk to cross the street to school property. *\*Our Safety Patrol staff has been instructed to take down license plates of cars that are a safety concern.*
- 3. Please heed and respect all posted street and traffic signs and be remember to be mindful of your speed slow and safe. \**Reminder speed limit is 20mph during school hours*.
- 4. Please exercise caution when driving down 47<sup>th</sup> and adjacent side streets as there is a lot of congestion between buses, pedestrians, and cars.

#### **GENERAL TRAFFIC RULES & REMINDERS**

- **<u>Please observe all posted street signs</u>** Much of the curb is off limits for parking during specific hours, this includes the portion of the curb at the "T" intersections.
- **U-turns are illegal** If you need to turn around, please use the designated turnabout located just past the park by the tennis courts at SW 43<sup>rd</sup> Ave.

- Please do not block driveways, mailboxes, or fire hydrants. Remember to be courteous and respectful of our neighbors.
- Cars should <u>never double park</u> to let kids exit into the street to cross. If there is no place to pull completely over, please drive down towards the park where there is more space available.
- Parking lot is reserved for **<u>staff only</u>** during the school day.

Thank you for your understanding. Your attention and cooperation is appreciated as we work together to have a positive impact in ensuring the safety of our students.

SafeOregon was funded by the Oregon Legislature as part of a statewide effort to improve school safety. It provides a secure means for anyone to anonymously report suspicious or imminently unsafe situations, such as threats of violence, fights, drugs and alcohol, weapons, bullying, harassment, intimidation or self-harm.

Anyone, from students to parents to community members, can access the system in a variety of ways, including:
