MESSAGE FROM NUTRITION SERVICES

PANDEMIC EBT UPDATE FOR FAMILIES

The Oregon Department of Human Services (ODHS) was approved to provide additional Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) benefits to eligible students enrolled from July 1 - September 22. Similar to the spring, benefits are provided to children who receive free or reduced price school meals through the National School Lunch Program that are not attending school in-person.

Every child who is eligible will receive at least \$100 and some will receive more benefits based on when school began. The initial \$100 benefits were distributed on September 28th. If a child qualifies for any additional benefits beyond \$100, this will be provided through a second deposit. Eligible students who receive Oregon SNAP benefits, or who received an Oregon EBT card in the mail with P-EBT benefits in the past, received these September P-EBT benefits on their existing Oregon EBT card. For lost EBT cards,

families can request a new one by calling a local ODHS office or calling the EBT replacement line 1-855-328-6715.

If eligible families did not receive P-EBT benefits, they can send an email to the PPS Meal Benefits Office at mealbenefits@pps.net with the following information: Student name, school name, and parent contact information (address, phone). Once the student is verified as eligible an email will be sent to the P-EBT email address (ebt.schoolmeals@dhsoha.state.or.us) on the behalf of the family for follow up.

Updates to Meal Service as Weather Changes, Distance Learning Continues

Dear PPS Families,

With the announcement that Portland Public Schools is extending Comprehensive Distance Learning through at least January 28, we want to make you aware of upcoming updates to our meal service as we adjust to the coming colder weather and shorter days.

We will be pausing services at Clarendon, Sacajawea and Harriet Tubman Middle School due to low participation. The last day of service at these three locations will be Friday, October 30. Families who have been visiting these sites are encouraged to visit one of the other PPS meal sites close by or request home meal delivery.

Starting November 2, our grab-and-go curbside serving locations will be open from 3 to 4:30 p.m. every Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Some schools might shift their serving location on campus to help keep employees dry and visible. To see the full list of meal sites, please visit the Nutrition Sites During Distance Learning website.

Finally, we are reopening access to home meal deliveries, a service for PPS families that are not near a meal site or need assistance accessing meals. To request meal delivery service, please <u>complete the request form</u>. We continue to assess the capacity of both the Nutrition Services and Transportation departments and will keep you apprised of any updates we make to our services.

The Bridlemile TAG night will be an opportunity to learn about TAG at PPS this year and the TAG identification process. This event is for both parents of currently TAG identified students and parents who are interested in beginning the identification process for their student.

Please note that due to limitations of distance learning, the timeline and process for TAG identification look a bit different this year. Since standardized tests (state OSAS tests, MAP assessments, and 2nd-grade universal screener) have all been on hold since last March, we currently lack the data required to complete a TAG identification for students in grades K-3. While parents can still begin the identification process for those students, be aware that the process will not be completed until some form of testing is resumed.

For parents of 4th and 5th graders interested in beginning the identification process, it is more likely that the process will be able to be completed this fall/winter provided that your student completed the MAP assessment last winter. Applications for 4th and 5th grade students who did not complete the MAP last year will similarly be in process until standardized testing resumes.

The TAG night event will be recorded, so if you are not able to attend, or have additional questions, please contact Mr. Stenger at pstenger@pps.net.

- 1. Click on the link below for your child's teacher. The link will bring you to a Google calendar specific to each teacher so you will need to sign in with a Google account to access it. Student accounts will work fine if no parent Google account is available.
- 2. Advance the calendar to Nov. 23-24 (there is a link at the bottom of the page that will do this automatically)

3. Click on the available time slot that you want to claim. Click on save to finalize your sign-up.

<u>Greetings to all Families from your School Nurse, Trudy Davis BSN, RN</u>

Flu season is here and it's never too early or too late to get your flu shot. The flu shot remains our best defense against contracting the flu. It is especially important now due to the COVID-19 pandemic to protect yourself against the flu. The County Health Department provides the following information about the flu.

The flu is a contagious disease caused by influenza germs. Flu can lead to mild to serious illness, and can sometimes lead to hospitalization and death.

Flu is spread from person to person by coughing, sneezing, talking or singing.

Adults and children should get a flu shot each year.

You should also stay home if you are sick. Cover coughs and sneezes, and wash your hands frequently with soap and water, or use a hand sanitizer to avoid getting sick.

Please contact me at tdavis@mesd.k12.or.us if you have any questions or need resources to access health care in general. This year due to CoVid-19 flu vaccine clinics are not scheduled with the county at this time. However, families can go to any pharmacy and get their flu shot generally for free depending on insurance. This is quite convenient, as pharmacies are located in many grocery stores, like Safeway or Fred Meyer. Kaiser patients can access the website with their member ID https://thrive.kaiserpermanente.org/care-near-oregon-southwest-washington. There is a drive through option at Clackamas Town Center and there may be other drive through options as well.
