### Latinx Heritage month is underway!

Latinx Heritage month is observed from Sept. 15, to Oct. 15, and celebrates the histories, cultures and contributions of those whose ancestors came from Spain, Mexico, the Caribbean, and Central and South America. Latinx is a recently adopted gender-neutral alternative to Latina or Latino. It is a term used to describe a diverse group of people who have roots in Latin America.

The date of September 15 is significant, as it is the anniversary of independence for Latin American countries Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua. In addition, Mexico and Chile celebrate their independence days on Sept. 16 and 18, respectively.

The observation started in 1968 as Hispanic Heritage Week under President Lyndon Johnson, and was expanded by President Ronald Reagan in 1988 to cover a 30-day period starting on Sept. 15 and ending on Oct. 15.

**3rd, 4th & 5th** grade boys and girls Bridlemile basketball teams play in the City of Portland Goldenball Youth Basketball Program. Practices usually start in mid-November with one or two 1-hour practices per week. Regular season games begin January 15th and run through February

26th with one game per week on Saturdays. Practice times will be after school in the evenings and will be determined once the teams are selected. This is a recreational, skillbuilding program. The cost is typically around \$80 per player which includes a uniform. Fees are collected by each team AFTER the teams have been formed and the link for uniforms is shared separately.

A coaches/organizers meeting will be held on-line Wednesday, October 13th and Coaches will contact players after teams are formed.
