

MESSAGE FROM PRINCIPAL TOWNSEND



In our continued effort to limit the spread of COVID-19 in our communities, Bridlemile will participate in a weekly COVID-19 Screening Testing Program, a partnership between the Oregon Health and Science University (OHSU) and PPS. Screening testing provides early detection of COVID-19, even when individuals have no apparent COVID-19-like symptoms.

If you are interested in having your student(s) participate in this free weekly COVID-19 screening testing program, please be sure to return a signed copy of the opt-ins provided to your student earlier this week.

If I enroll my student in this testing program, what should I expect?

- 1. Families who wish to participate in the testing program must fill out the consent forms and health authorization forms we sent with your student on Friday, September 24, 2021 or Monday, September 27, 2021.
- 2. Our school will receive testing kits and labels to send home every Thursday.
- 3. We ask you that every Friday morning, your student spit into the test tube. We encourage you to watch <u>this 4 minute video</u> on how easy it is to collect a spit sample.
- 4. Please return the spit samples that same morning. Dropboxes will be located at the Bridlemile front/main entrance. Samples will be collected by OHSU for transportation to the lab for testing.
- 5. OHSU will share the results within 48 hours of the specimen being dropped off at school. You will receive a secure email with your child's results. Please note: PPS will not receive the results of your student's test.

If it is a positive (or inconclusive) result, we ask that you keep your student home from school. **Please call us immediately** and we will follow the guidance provided by our

partners at the Multnomah Health Department.

We know that this is an important tool in our effort to prevent the spread of COVID-19. It's also important to remember that despite the availability of this program, the best tools to protect individuals against COVID-19 are vaccination for those eligible, physical distancing, masks, proper ventilation and airflow, hand hygiene, and staying home if ill or exposed to someone with COVID-19.

We are excited for the launch of this screening testing program, helping us make more informed decisions about our students safety and health.

School Pay

SchoolPay is an online web tool that allows families to pay for items such as registration fees, athletic fees, event tickets, uniforms, library fees and donations without having to make a special trip to the school or send a check with their students. It also provides the convenience of paying by Visa, MasterCard or Discover Card online or onsite.

Parents and guardians, you are able to use one log-in at SchoolPay to see all items available to you. You will also be able to see the payment history for each of your students.

School Bus MyStop App!!

MyStop is an app you can use on your smartphone (Apple or Android), iPad or Tablet, or your laptop or desktop computer.

What does MyStop do?

With My Stop, parents, guardians and students know approximately what time their school bus will arrive at their home stop — all from a smart phone, mobile device or computer. The school bus location updates automatically and the ETA recalculates to accommodate any delays due to traffic while in route. <u>Note</u>** there may be times when the app has not updated due to a change in bus number (i.e. a bus is swapped out say for a mechanical issue-and the new bus number is not uploaded; if you were tracking your bus, it would show the location at the

dispatch center, and not the new bus that was en route to you).

It can be used by both the parent/guardian and the student. You will only be able to see your student's bus info but not other students.

Picture Day School Process:

- Pictures will be held in the Cafeteria
- Each Classroom will sign up for a dedicated/individual timeslot
- Only one class in the cafeteria at a time
- Only 2 students at a time getting their picture taken
- The 2 cameras will be set up and spaced more than 6 ft apart
- Students can either:
 - Lower their mask and have their picture taken (this should ideally take 10 seconds and no more than 30 seconds)
 - Have their picture taken with their mask on
 - Opt out of picture day (if you choose to opt out, please let your teacher know)
- Students in queue will wait in line spaced at minimum 3 ft apart in the cafeteria
