Tiered Registration Process

Early Registration is offered first for scholarship, and payment plan families. These families register in person in Room 108.

What is Schools Uniting Neighborhoods (SUN)?

Our Schools Uniting Neighborhoods program enriches the Buckman community by offering low-cost, educationally enriching after-school and before-school classes; day camps on many no-school days; community gatherings such as Family Write or Math Nights; community building events and family dances; parenting and life skills classes for parents; and social services coordination for struggling students and families. Buckman's SUN program is a collaboration of Multnomah County Department of County Human Services, the City of Portland Parks and Recreation, Impact Northwest and Portland Public Schools.

Programming Basics

SUN follows the Portland Public School calendar, & tries to provide coverage for schools out days in addition to after school classes.

Our after school program follows this schedule:

3:00-3:10~Snack & Attendance 3:10-3:25~Quick Recess 3:30-4:25~First Class 4:30-5:30~Second Class 5:30-6:00~Late Care

You may sign up for just a first class, or both first & second class.

Scholarships

Scholarships are offered to lowincome families. 50% reduced rate is automatically offered when families provide their current Free & Reduced Lunch form. Scholarships exceeding 50% are also an option. Contact Diane, or Brittany for this assistance.

SUN TERMINOLOGY

Classes vs. camps: classes are educational opportunities we offer throughout the term, on a weekly basis, which follow a strict schedule. If you sign up for a class such as Cranium Club on Mondays, from 3:30-4:30, your child will go to this class every Monday for the entire term. Camps are offered during the school year when school is closed, but the building is open, such as teacher planning days.

Partners: Community groups who you must pay separately. SUN does not handle partner money at all. However, limited scholarships are available through SUN office.

Lottery classes: Popular classes where enrollment is determined by a random drawing process. Lottery forms are shared with Buckman families, and must be turned in by the date set by SUN to be considered.

Inclusionary Services: Students with IEPs qualifying for one-on-one support to assist them in group activities. Families must gain approval for this specific care.
