ABOUT IMMUNIZATIONS

Per Oregon law, children whose immunization records are not current by **February 19, 2020** will not be able to attend school until their information is up to date.

If your child's immunization records are incomplete you can get your child vaccinated *before the deadline* by making an appointment at one of our Student Health Centers.
